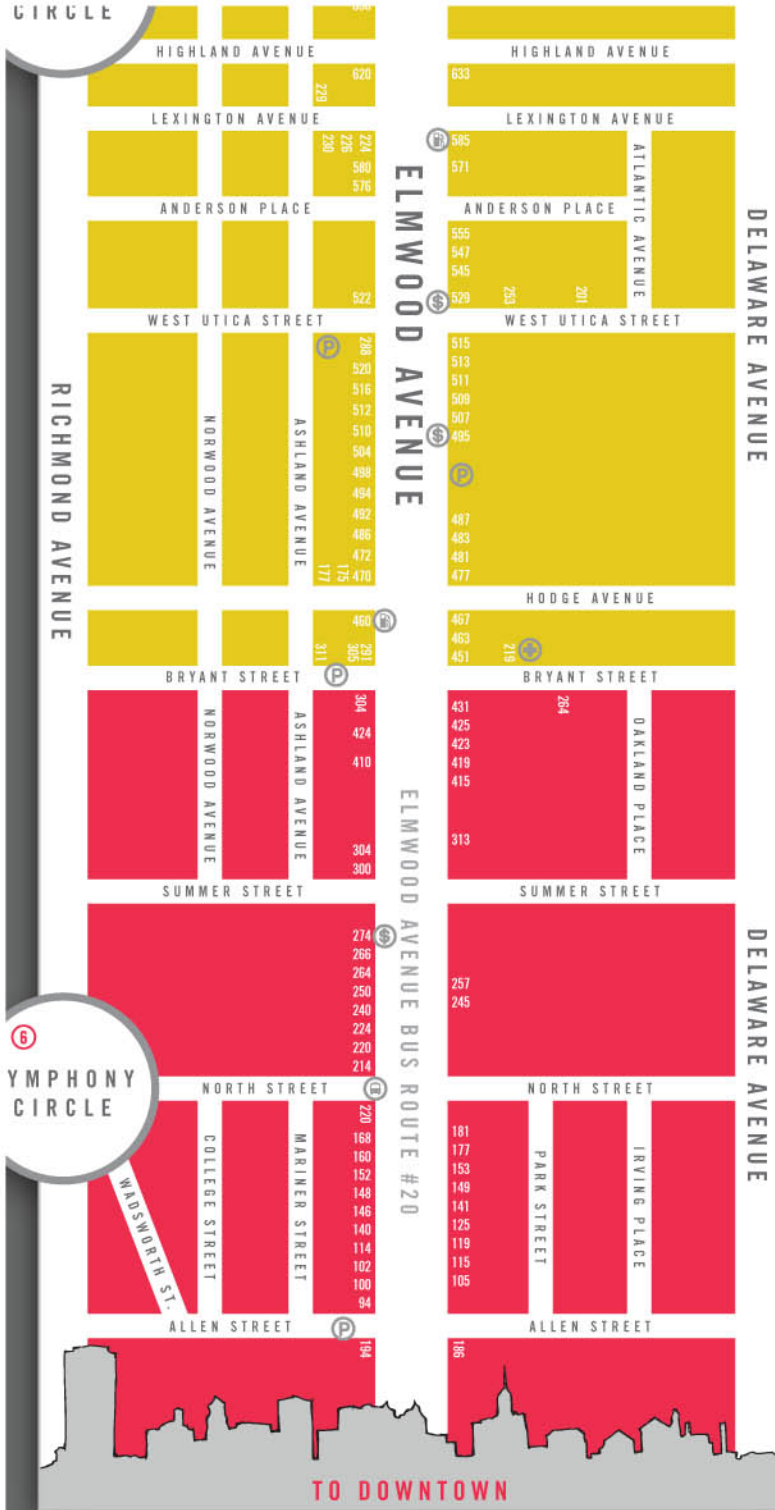

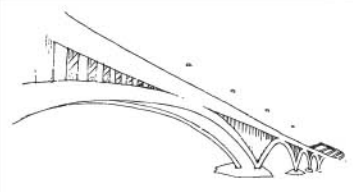

1 BURCHFIELD PENNEY ART CENTER

The paintings of Charles Burchfield and other WNY artists are the focus of this new 80,000-square-foot museum, which opened in 2008 and was designed by world-famous architects Gwathmey Siegel and Associates.



2 BUFFALO STATE COLLEGE

Buffalo State College was founded in 1871 as a teacher's college, and was later introduced into the State University of New York system in the late 1940s. Today, the school offers more than 200 undergraduate and graduate degrees.



3 RICHARDSON OLMSTED COMPLEX

The complex, once an insane asylum, was design by noted American architect H.H. Richardson and landscape architect Frederick Law Olmsted, known for his Buffalo parkway design and New York City's Central Park.



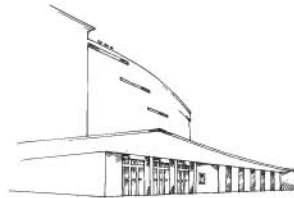
4 BUFFALO & ERIE COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY

The Historical Society was founded by President Millard Fillmore in 1862, and opened its doors to this museum after the close of the Pan-American Exposition in 1901. This was the only permanent building constructed for the Pan-Am.



5 ALBRIGHT-KNOX ART GALLERY

The Albright-Knox is home to an impressive collection of post-war American and European art, and includes works by seminal artists of impressionism, expressionism, surrealism and pop art periods. Pieces by Picasso, Matisse, Pollack, Mondrian, Warhol and van Gogh are featured.



6 KLEINHANS MUSIC HALL

Kleinhans Music Hall opened in 1940 as the home of the Buffalo Philharmonic Orchestra, which still plays classical and pops concerts in the breathtaking music hall, which is located at Symphony Circle in Allentown.

BLUE BANNERS

The north section of the Elmwood Village serves a varied population of college students, young families and longtime residents. It features two major art galleries — The Albright-Knox Art Gallery and The Burchfield Penney Art Center — Buffalo State College, The Buffalo and Erie County Historical Society and The Buffalo State Hospital (an H.H. Richardson and Frederick Law Olmstead masterpiece), in addition to many shops and restaurants.

GREEN BANNERS

Nestled between all the great shops on Elmwood are trendy cafés, restaurants, chocolatiers, and many other great stops. Whether you are shopping for yourself or someone important to you, when you want the “best of Buffalo,” the active and growing Green section of Elmwood is the place to be.

DIRECTIONS

FROM SOUTHERN ONTARIO / PEACE BRIDGE:

The Elmwood Village shopping district begins at Allen Street and runs about 4 kilometers north along Elmwood Avenue to Forest Avenue. After crossing over the Peace Bridge, follow Moore Drive through historic Front Park to Porter Avenue. At the traffic signal make a left on Porter and continue to Symphony Circle. Take the Symphony Circle rotary to North Street. Take North Street to Elmwood Avenue and enter Red Street Banner Elmwood Village district.

FROM NIAGARA FALLS / NIAGARA CROSSINGS / NORTHERN BUFFALO SUBURBS:

Take NYS I-190 south to Buffalo. Exit Route 198 (Scajaquada Expressway). Travel 1 mile and take Elmwood Avenue exit. From exit ramp make a right and then an immediate left onto Elmwood Avenue. Travel south to the Blue Street Banner section of Elmwood Avenue.

FROM POINTS EAST (ROCHESTER / EASTERN SUBURBS):

Take NYS I-90 west to Buffalo exit Route 33 west (Kensington/Martin Luther King Jr. Expressway). Exit Route 198 (Scajaquada Expressway). Take Elmwood Avenue South/Albright Knox Art Gallery exit. Make a right onto Elmwood Avenue. Travel ¾ mile to Forest Avenue and beginning of Blue Street Banner Elmwood Village district.

FROM POINTS SOUTH (ERIE / PITTSBURGH / CLEVELAND):

Take NYS I-90 east to Buffalo. Exit NYS I-190 north to Downtown Buffalo. Exit Route 198 (Scajaquada Expressway). Travel 1 mile and take Elmwood Avenue exit. From exit ramp make a right and then an immediate left onto Elmwood Avenue. Travel south to Forest Avenue and the Blue Street Banner district of Elmwood Village.

YELLOW BANNERS

The Yellow section of Elmwood Avenue is a mix of fine retail, upscale dining and some of Buffalo's more exclusive nightlife. Take a detour off the main strip down Lexington Avenue to find beautiful houses, a block of studios and shops, in addition to one of the city's best sushi restaurants.

RED BANNERS

Historic Allentown

Elmwood's Red section includes historic Allentown, Buffalo's most electric arts neighborhood. Along Elmwood Avenue and Allen Street you will find shops devoted to arts of all mediums — photography, painting, graphic design, music, crafts, literary arts and much more. For those searching for old treasures, this neighborhood has several beautiful antique shops selling everything from the historic to the funky and unique. The Red area is also where one will find beautiful imported, fair-trade goods from Latin America, several African shops and other one-of-a-kind finds.

DOWNTOWN

The downtown Buffalo of today is different than it was just a few years ago. Large warehouses and department stores of yesteryear have been converted into stunning loft apartments, and a thriving theater district is home to more than a half-dozen stages. But it's the bustling dining and nightlife scene that is the backbone of the downtown experience. Don't forget the waterfront, overlooking scenic Lake Erie and the Niagara River.
